



# DISCRIMINATION IS AGAINST THE LAW



Stone Memorial High School District programs and activities shall be free from discrimination based on age, gender, gender identity or expression, or genetic information, sex, race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, ethnic group identification, marital or parental status, physical or mental disability, sexual orientation; the perception of one or more of such characteristics; or association with a person or group with one or more of these actual or perceived characteristics.

Part 106	Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in all programs or activities that receive Federal financial assistance.  34 C.F.R. Part 104	Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability by public entities.  28 C.F.R. Part 35
